Remember to re-register for the upcoming summer semester 2021 between **1st of February** and **8th of February**!

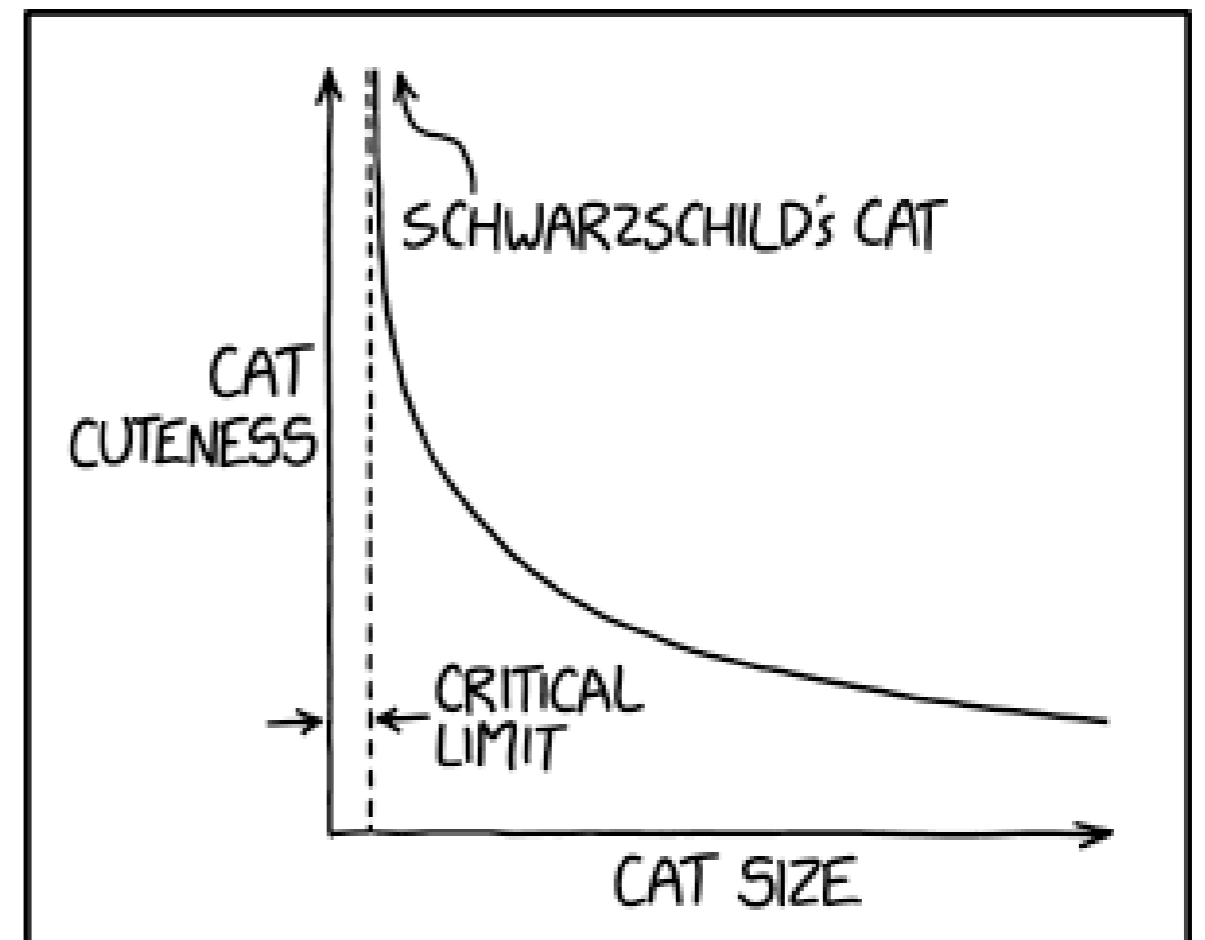
