Research Oriented Study Programme (ger.: FSG) - Physics

As a part of the Bavarian Elite Network, the University of Erlangen-Nuremberg and the University of Regensburg, offer special courses in the Bachelor's and Master's degree programmes. The aim of which is to integrate interested students into real everyday research as early as possible. The research phase usually begins after the third semester and also includes an integrated doctoral level course of lectures. The participation in the accelerated program of study requires very high qualifications, which are to be tested by the selection committee.

If this short description of the FSG has aroused your interest, then you can apply via Campo until the 15th of August. Unfortunately, this will be the last chance to experience the FSG in its current system, so the temptation to just give it a try seems even bigger. What to do in the event of harassment or discrimination?

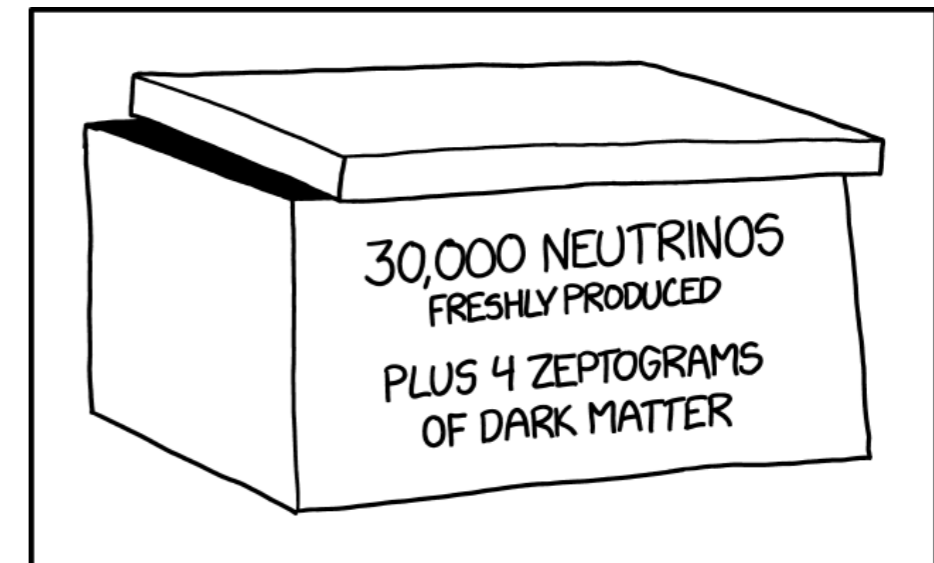
Harassment and discrimination should not be tolerated. Also it is important to actively help those affected and to draw attention to the topicality of the problem.

The directive on preventing and dealing with cases of discrimination, harassment and sexual harassment recommends contacting an initial and referral counseling center first. In most cases, the Office for Gender and Diversity (imke.leicht@fau.de) is the right address for this. They will discuss with you which individual steps are the best for you, from the arbitration procedure and moderated discussions to the formal complaints procedure.

You don't have to keep any burden inside if you don't want to. Let somebody support you. Be it from the official side, the circle of friends or the family.
