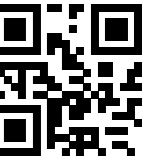

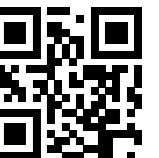
Language centre and sport courses

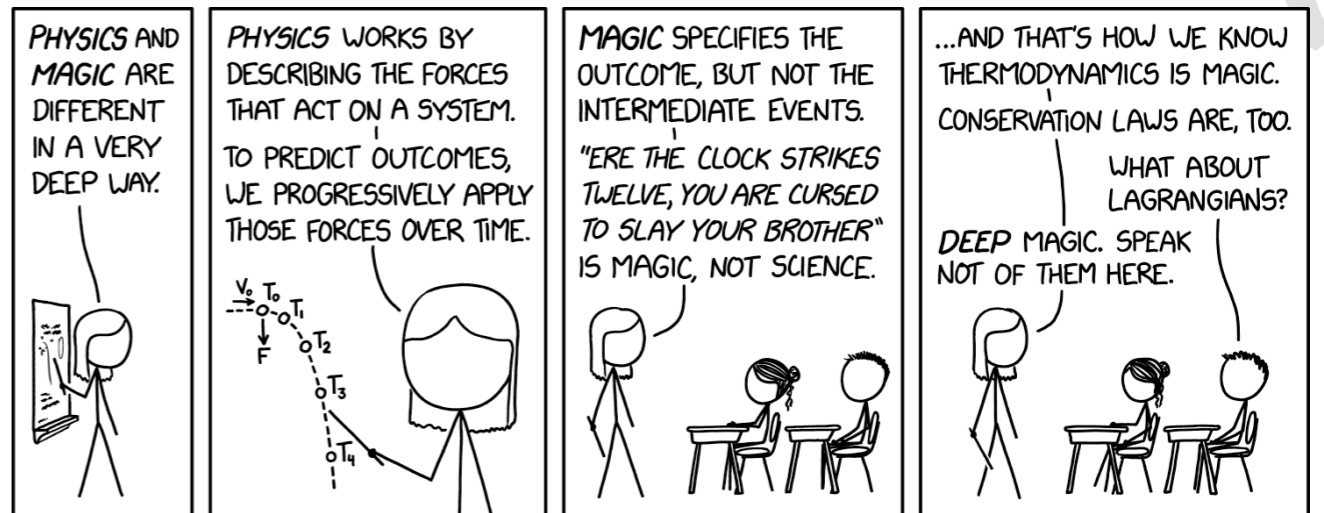
